RESULTS OF ENGR RECON OF AGHO RIVER BETWEEN BAYAMBANG AND AMONPEREZ:
BAYAMBANG TO AMONPEREZ WIDTH 300 TO 700 FT, DEPTH 4 FT TO 6 FT, CURRENT 5 MPH
NOW DUE TO RAINS. CIVILIANS REPORT 2 MPH NORMAL. BANKS INSIDE OF RIVER BENDS
SHALLOW AND OUTSIDE OF BENDS 6 FT HIGH AVERAGE. BANKS COVERED WITH 6 TO 7 FT HIGH
KUNAI TYPE GRASS. NO FORDS BETWEEN BAYAMBANG AND AMONPEREZ AND CIVILIANS REPORT
NONE BETWEEN BAYAMBANG AND CARMEN. POSSIBLE PONTON SITES OLEA AND ALACOLA. OLEA
SITE UNUSEABLE DUE TO LACK OF ROADS ON NORTH BANK, ALACOLA SITE USEABLE IF ROAD
BETWEEN ALACOLA AND ^{BARANGOBONG} ~~BARANGOBONG~~ IS MADE INTO AN ALL WEATHER ROAD. APPROACHES TO
SITES FROM SOUTH BANK ARE PAIR AND MAY BE EASILY CONNECTED TO EXISTING ROAD NET.
ROAD BETWEEN BAYAMBANG AND ALACOLA ONE WAY WITH THIN COATING OF GRAVEL ON SILTY
SAND BASE WHICH WOULD BECOME IMPASSIBLE UNDER HEAVY TRAFFIC IN WET WEATHER. RAIL-
ROAD BRIDGE AT BAYAMBANG STEEL TRETTLE NOW OPEN TO JEEPS WILL CARRY ANY LOAD SUBJECT
ONLY TO WIDTH OF VEHICLES. FURTHER RECON BETWEEN AMANPEREZ AND CARMEN NOW IN
PROCESS. REPORT WILL BE MADE UPON COMPLETION.
